

WHY BUY FROM LOCAL FARMERS?

Agriculture plays an important role in Surrey's economy, with approximately one-third of Surrey's total land base zoned agricultural. Home to over 475 farms, Surrey is a significant producer of the province's vegetables.

We encourage you to support local farms and to experience agriculture in the City. In an ongoing effort to promote agricultural growth in our community, the City has published this Farm Fresh Guide to help you get to know the source of your food by visiting farms, markets and u-pick locations.

Buying local products is also a healthy choice for you and the environment. By eating products that are in season and available from local farms your foods will be ripe and fresh, and you will reduce the shipping distances your food makes. Shorter shipping distances mean less fuel consumed leading to fewer vehicle emissions. It will also be less likely that your foods will be involved in preservation or ripening processes used during international shipping.

Community Supported Agriculture

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is an economic business model that helps farmers cover the startup costs for each growing season, and enables farmers and consumers to share the risks and benefits of food production. CSA members pay for a share of the anticipated harvest at the beginning of the growing season. Once harvest begins, they receive a weekly box of veggies or other farm products. CSAs are a great way to support farmers, eat local, try out new veggies and cut down on the time you spend grocery shopping! A number of Surrey farms offer CSA programs, including:
