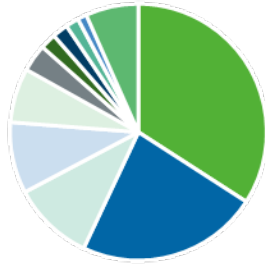

Business Case Success

- The Manufacturing Safety Alliance of BC saw the largest decrease in premium rates compared to all other WorkSafeBC Industry Sectors in 2016
- On average, the CU's we represent saw a 19 cent reduction in premiums per \$100 of employers' assessable payroll – a decrease of 7.2%

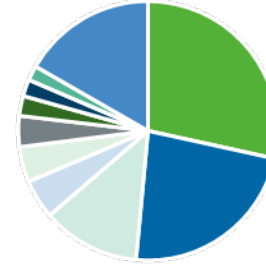
