SCORING CRITERIA

Based on a possible maximum score of 100, each category will be awarded a maximum of 20 points:

1. **Intellectual Achievement** - The degree of intellectual achievement or quality of ingenious thinking and experiment to discover, create or conceive the innovation.
2. **Uniqueness and Originality** - Refers to the state of being original; the freshness of aspect, design or style utilized to produce the invention.
3. **Development** - Refers to the extent to which the idea or concept has been thought through to completion.
4. **Commercialization** - Refers to the degree of successful commercialization or quantifiable impact of the innovation.
5. **Benefits** - Refers to the economic and/or social benefit to Canada resulting from the innovation.
