 Urgent (timely) Primary Care – visits for timely access to care for unattached and attached clients

#### Models of Care

## Primary Care - examples

- Physical check-ups
- Prevention, early detection and management of disease – screening
- Disease diagnosis and treatment
- Chronic disease management
- Support for self-management
- Reproductive care

## Urgent (Timely) Care - examples

- Management of minor illnesses ear aches, sore throat, fever, infections
- Management of sprains
- Suturing of small wounds
- Management of medications
- Crisis intervention for mental health challenges
