# Goal: 10\% Reduction Waste Generation (Achieved 11\%) <br> Generation $=$ Recycled + Disposed 

Goal: 80\% Recycling Rate
(Achieved 65\%)
Recycling Rate $=$ Recycled $/$ Generated

- Municipal organics services upon request

## WASTE-TO-ENERGY FACILITY DISTRICT ENERGY PROJECT



- No change in Waste-toEnergy Facility emissions or amount of waste processed
- Triples energy recovery
- Heat and hot water for up to 50,000 homes
- Up to 70,000 tonnes per year of GHG emission reductions
- Self-funded over life of project
