Organization: Alivio Technologies and SFU Mechatronics System Engineering

This student-led initiative strives to analyze local matters within the community and enforce change through a fundraising campaign and direct interactions with those that need help. These projects include support to combat the water crisis in the Ojibwe community of Neskantaga First Nation and Open Mic for Youth to express experiences of discrimination. She has received several writing distinctions, including national recognition from the League of Canadian Poets for the Jessamy Stursberg Poetry Prize in 2022 and placing third in the Surrey Libraries' Youth Writing Contest the same year.

Age: 25

Helen serves as President of the Simon Fraser Student Society (SFSS). This student association aims to provide critical services to over 26,000 undergraduate students, including administering health and dental insurance and providing financial grants for student-led clubs. As a student advocate and President, she advanced the Student Housing Rights initiative, allocated \$10,000 to retrofit ablution spaces and accommodate students' prayer space accessibility needs, and curated and published the 2022 SFSS BC Public Post-Secondary Education Funding Review Report, which lobbied BC's provincial government to enhance policies regarding affordable student housing, and to establish a 2% tuition cap for international students. In 2021, she was awarded the Gunraj Gill Memorial Award for Political Science.

At the onset of COVID-19, Jasmeen started an initiative called Dreams of Hope, where she donated about 50 care kits to the homeless shelters in Surrey. Her community leadership has earned her various recognitions and scholarships, such as the District Authority Scholarship, the Youth Volunteer Award from the Canadian Federation of Fijo Organizations, and a Youth Champion of Diversity Award nominee. The ongoing opioid crisis led Joban to establish the not-for-profit organization A Second Chance - Harm Reduction Society. He educates community members on reducing the stigma around substance use by providing emotional support, training, and resources. Joban is a trained naloxone-use instructor, obtaining his certification from Fraser Health and the Provincial Health Services Authority. He was twice awarded as athlete of the year and as a provincial gold medallist as a captain of his soccer team. Joban has recently graduated with distinction from the University of British Columbia with a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in science in chemistry, Earth and ocean science and life sciences.

When war was launched on Ukraine, Madison, with mixed Indigenous and Ukrainian heritage, knew that something had to be done. She turned Slava Sweatshirts Inc. from a passion project to a social media fashion campaign for Ukraine, gaining the attention of American and Canadian political communities, media outlets and global communities. Proceeds went to Ukraine National Bank and Red Cross' humanitarian efforts. In the past, she has fundraised for Atira Woman's Resource Society, Indian Residential School Survivors Society and Run for the Cure, where she was in the top 7 fundraisers in the country. Currently, Madison is pursuing a Juris Doctor of Law degree at Bond University in Australia. She obtained her Bachelor of Arts in Political Science and Government with a minor in Media and Communications. She plans to open her own Indigenous law firm when she returns to Canada later this year.

Monika is the Co-founder of Young Minds Exploring Science. This science outreach organization is committed to providing all students with the opportunity to engage in enriching science opportunities without any financial barriers. Monika chairs the 2023 University of British Columbia Student Leadership Conference, served as Co-Chair of Minerva BC's Youth Advisory Council in 2021 and 2022 and launched Mindful Moments, a Spotify podcast to amplify youth voices. Working as a full-time Research Assistant at the BC Children's Hospital BioBank, Qudrat leads the Patient-Family Advisory Committee, where patients and their parents work alongside research staff to develop strategies to move toward patient-centred care. Sarthak's entrepreneurial mindset, leadership skills and enthusiasm for STEM paved the way for him to develop projects that would positively impact his community. He developed a smart cane for visually impaired individuals to aid navigation while preventing fatal incidents. He created a self-driving robot capable of detecting and extinguishing fires. He also developed an advanced home security system to curb the increasing theft cases in his neighbourhood. As the captain of the Robotics team in high school, he provided guidance and taught STEM and problem-solving skills, leading them to win the Top Rookie Team Award and earn third place nationally in the 2020 "FIRST Robotics" Championships. Currently, Sarthak is in his first year studying general engineering at the University of British Columbia.

Organization: NailSight App

Age: 17

Numerous cardiovascular, liver, kidney, and lung diseases are undetectable in their early stages but have unnoticeable manifestations in the fingernails. Simrit developed a mobile application called Nailsight App to allow detection and diagnosis of these diseases through simple pictures of your fingernails. Using Convolutional Neural Networks, Nailsight can detect various diseases and conditions by visual diagnostics of fingernails. The CNN algorithms achieved an 85% accuracy rate proving its viability. Simrit was named a finalist in the Rise Scholarship Program for this innovation. She was a top 10 Global Winner in the Microsoft Imagine Cup Junior Competition, and a finalist in the Climate Science Olympiad. Simrit is a high school student at Semiahmoo Secondary.

Organization: Melius Mentorship Network

Age: 22

Sohat established Melius Mentorship Network to provide one-on-one mentorship to newcomers and Surrey youth about post-secondary school options and free academic tutoring and guidance. He and his team received over \$12,000 in funding from the University of British Columbia's Centre of Community through the Chapman and Connect 2 Community grants. They hosted 10 STEAM-based workshops in partnership with the Surrey Schools Welcome Centre and Pacific Community Resources Society. Sohat is in his final year of the Integrated Sciences program at the University of British Columbia. Moreover, Sohat is an athlete who competed as a Powerlifter, where he won a bronze medal at the BC Powerlifting Association's Legend of the Three Lifts Powerlifting Meet.

Zora is a true leader who has made an enormous difference in the community through his role with the Surrey School District's Next 100-year Mentorship program, and the City of Surrey with the Youth Squad and Surrey Steps Up.
